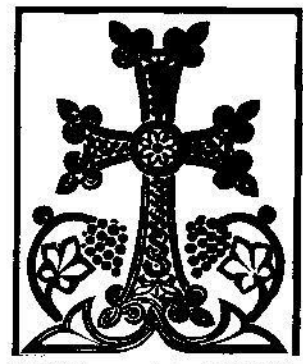

A LETTER TO THE EDITOR ABOUT BENJAMIN CREME

On Sat. June 29, 1991 the well known Scottish esotericist Benjamin Creme, lectured at the Unitarian-Universalist Community Church in NYC. Last year Mr. Creme had given his annual NYC lecture at the Rutgers Presbyterian Church. The Remy Letter reported his 1990 appearance in its Autumn-Winter issue (v.11, #4).

The President of the Lucis Trust, Sara McKechnie, objected to our informative news analysis in a letter to the editor, dated Oct. 29, '90. For your information her letter is reprinted on the next page, followed by the Editor's response. That was in 1990. However, in the light of what Mr. Creme said again this year at the New York Community Church, Mrs. McKechnie's denial of any "purported link" between Bailey and Creme is an oxymoron!

Alice A. Bailey wrote over 24 books on the Ageless Wisdom and both Mr. Creme and countless others who have read them were, indeed, highly influenced by these books and the ideas in them. To underscore this point, at this year's lecture Mr. Creme spoke at length about Alice Bailey, Djwhal Khul and the Masters in general. As if to further underscore what was said in the lecture Tara Center, which sponsors Mr. Creme's US tours, handed out before the talk a brochure which listed for sale all of Alice Bailey's books. These books could be bought through Tara Center (Box 6001, N. Hollywood, CA 91603).

Now if Mrs. McKechnie vehemently denies any link between Creme and Bailey, why, and I repeat, WHY is the Lucis Trust shipping wholesale their publications for retail resale by Tara Center which is Mr. Creme's sponsor and the publisher of The Emergence and handler for correspondence, donations, invoices, orders, mailing lists, and Share International subscriptions for Mr. Creme's work in the Western Hemisphere? Mr. Creme, himself, is the editor of the magazine, Share International!



Dear Mr. Spataro,

We were distressed to read, in the Remy Letter for Autumn-Winter 1990-1, of a purported link between the work of Benjamin Creme and Alice Bailey, who founded the Lucis Trust and wrote a series of 24 books on the Ageless Wisdom. We do not believe that there is any "intimate link" or similarity between their work, and whenever we have the opportunity, we make as clear as possible the fact that the Lucis Trust has no connection with Mr. Creme's activities.

If you read Alice Bailey's The Reappearance of the Christ, you will find that the teaching of Djwhal Khul concerning the reappearance, and the preparatory work necessary for humanity to carry out prior to Christ's reappearance, are quite different than the statements Benjamin Creme has been putting forth for some years. In fact, Mr. Creme claims that the Christ is already here and living in London, awaiting the discovery of the media, whereas the conditions which the Tibetan outlines in The Reappearance of the Christ indicate quite clearly that humanity has a ways to go in the accomplishment of its responsibilities before the Christ can return to a receptive, responsive world atmosphere.

THE QUESTION OF THE AGELESS MASTERS

Madame Blavatsky, Alice Bailey and Benjamin Creme, all three, speak of the Ageless Masters of Wisdom or The Hierarchy. In vol. 10, no. 5 (June '91) Share International, edited by Benjamin Creme, in its column "Questions & Answers" explains about the "ageless" Masters: "Q. In the March issue of Share International it says that the Master Jesus has been in the same physical body for 563 years. Is this a long time for a Master to be incarnate? A. It is middling to short. Some of the Masters are 100, 150, 200 years old - but there are Masters who are literally thousands of years old. Their bodies are ageless, timeless, they never change."

In his June 29, 1991 lecture Mr. Creme stated that Waitreya, the present World Teacher and Head of the Hierarchy of Masters, emerged in July 1977 from his ancient center in the high Himalayan fastness where HE HAD LIVED FOR SOME 2,600 YEARS! In addition Benjamin Creme claims to be in telepathic communication with his very own Master (A Master Speaks) whose name Mr. Creme as yet will not reveal. This other Master is another one of the Ageless Masters of Wisdom from the Hierarchy like Master M and Djwhal Khul.

In his most illuminating book, The Ancient Patriarchs and their Teachings (Hermetic Order of Light), George Boyer has this to state about the ageless Masters: "The character Ziusudra in this story (Gilgamesh) is mentioned as being the last antediluvian ruler reigning for a period of 36,000 years. Some identity with long life periods can be seen here with the very long life's spans of the Biblical Patriarchs. Biologists tell us that there is no reason why 'physical' bodies should age and die because a continual process of renewing is taking place in every living cell...the teaching of the Patriarchs has remained intact in the minds and hearts of a long succession of teachers who were, and still are, instructed by those beings who, for want of a better term, have been known to us as the Elohim."
